Ibn Battuta was a famous Arab explorer who wrote a book about his travels. He was born in 1304 in Tangier, in Morocco. He made his first journey when he was 21 years old, when he set off on a pilgrimage to Makkah. At first, he hated travelling because he felt lonely. However, during the next 28 years he travelled over 120,000 kilometers.

Ibn Battuta stayed in Makkah for three years. After Makkah, he travelled throughout Turkey, Russia and India, where he worked for a king for seven year. In 1342, the king of India sent him to the most powerful king in the world, the king of China, but his boat sank while it was sailing through a storm. However, Ibn Battuta survived , and in 1344, he reached China and travelled to the capital, Beijing. He spent many years in China before he travelled to his country, passing through Damascus, Cairo and Spain. During the last few years of his life, he wrote a book about his travels called " Travels in Asia and Africa" . Ibn Battuta died in 1368.
