

Eating well by colour

A) Read the following passage, then answer the questions below:

All plants contain *phytochemicals*, which protect them from harmful UV rays. We take in phytochemicals when we eat fruits and vegetables. Phytochemicals protect us from heart disease, cancer, Alzheimer's and other health issues. Phytochemicals have bright colours. For example, red foods, such as tomatoes and watermelon, contain *lycopene*, a



phytochemical that protects us from breast cancer. Orange foods, such as carrots and mangos, contain *Alpha and Beta carotene*, a phytochemical that keeps your eyes and bones healthy. Blue and purple foods, such as blackberries and blueberries, are full of *anthocyanins*, a phytochemical that keeps the heart and brain healthy. Yellow and green vegetables, such as corn and broccoli, contain phytochemicals that protect us from blindness and cancer.
